Former Officer Faces OVI Charges After Hit-Skip Accident

Toledo, OH (February 14, 2019): Kyle Martin, age 27, has resigned his position of police officer amid an internal investigation and ongoing traffic charges. On January 27, 2019, Toledo Police arrested Martin for Operating a Motor Vehicle under the Influence of Alcohol and Failure to Stop after an Accident. Martin's resignation ends his affiliation with the Toledo Police Department.
