Two In-Custody Following North Toledo Traffic Stop

Toledo, OH (September 6, 2019): Two suspects are in-custody for resisting arrest and assault on a police officer following a North Toledo traffic stop Friday evening. A short segment of the overall incident was posted on Facebook, accumulating numerous views and questions from commentators.

At approximately 5:30 p.m. this evening, Toledo Police Gang Task Force detectives, focusing on gun crime in the ShotSpotter area, conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle at Lagrange and Manhattan. The vehicle was occupied by the driver, Quinlan Cook, age 22, and one passenger, Jabril Wyley, age 21. While detectives were conducting their investigation, a bystander, later identified as Jannah Wyley, age 21, the twin sister of Jabril Wyley, approached the stop and was repeatedly asked to back away. Ms. Wyley refused to listen to detectives and began escalating the situation, with Mr. Wyley becoming increasingly uncooperative as well. As detectives attempted to detain Mr. Wyley in handcuffs for their safety, he began to resist and Ms. Wyley physically intervened - striking one detective multiple times in the face. Ultimately, both Mr. Wyley and Ms. Wyley were taken into custody, neither injured.

As with all incidents requiring increased action by officers to affect an arrest, this incident will be reviewed by the involved officers' command according to Toledo Police Department policy and procedure. This is the 34th report of an officer being assaulted thus far this year.
