SUBJECT: Increased Traffic Enforcement- July 4th Holiday period.

NARRATIVE:

The Toledo Police Department conducted a traffic enforcement blitz between July 3-July 5, 2020, during the July 4th holiday period. This enforcement blitz concentrated on all traffic violations with an emphasis placed on identifying speed and OVI (Operating a vehicle under the influence) offenders.

The following totals occurred during this traffic enforcement blitz:

Traffic stops: 53
No operator's license: 2
Suspended operator's license: 1
Speed violations: 19
Seatbelt violations: 1
Other violation: 4
Misdemeanor arrests: 2

This enforcement special is made possible by funding from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration in the form of a grant that is administered through the State of Ohio Department of Criminal Justice. Officers assigned to the special are paid on an overtime basis and are in addition to the regularly assigned officers on the shift.
